**ORDER SHORTENING NOTICE WITH REGARD TO MOTION OF DEBTORS AND
DEBTORS-IN-POSSESSION TO SHORTEN NOTICE WITH REGARD TO DEBTORS'
MOTION FOR AN ORDER PURSUANT TO SECTION 364(c)(2) OF THE
BANKRUPTCY CODE AUTHORIZING THE DEBTORS TO (I) ENTER INTO A
PERFORM UNDER AN INSURANCE PREMIUM FINANCING AGREEMENT WITH
AON PREMIUM FINANCE, LLC, AND (II) GRANTING RELATED RELIEF**

Upon consideration of Debtors' Motion pursuant to Del.Bankr.LR. 9006-1(e) for an Order shortening notice (the "Motion to Shorten Notice") with regard to the Debtors' Motion for entry of an order pursuant to section 364(c)(2) of title 11 of the United States Code (the "Bankruptcy Code") authorizing the Debtors to (i) enter into and perform under that certain Commercial Insurance Premium Finance and Security Agreement (the "Financing Agreement") with Aon Premium Finance, LLC ("Aon"), including paying all post-petition installment payments as such installment payments come due, and (ii) granting related relief (the "Insurance Premium Financing Motion"); and it appearing that sufficient cause exists for the relief granted herein, it is hereby

ORDERED as follows:

1. The Motion to Shorten Notice is GRANTED as set forth herein.
